


53 responses were received in total. Thank you for taking the time to respond.

My child is in: 53 responses




My child has settled back into school life post lockdown.


My child is well cared for by the staff in school. 53 responses




2021-2022 Priorities

- Emotional health and well-being: if a teacher who does not normally take a class has to step in to cover, they should first of all take note of which children have additional/special needs.


Actions:

- All teachers have made a 'Know my Class' leaflet which is given to any sub teacher. Should you have a complaint please do not hesitate to phone school.





SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT






