

# MENTAL MATHS TIP OF THE WEEK

How do the **reference points** work in practice? Let's have a tricky example:  $6 \times 7$ . If you can't remember  $6 \times 7$ , skip-count  $5 \times 7$  and add one more 7.



5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 35 1 2 3 4 5 6 7

 $5 \times 7 = 35$ 

Add an extra 7:

35 + 7 = 42

 $6 \times 7 = 42$ 

I start skip-counting with my left thumb, but it's not the only way to do it. Do what feels 'right' for you, as it will also be 'right' for your brain.

### **Mnemonics (memory triggers)**

 $7 \times 7 = 49$ 

Servant, servant! Faulty line! Seven times seven is forty nine.  $4 \times 4 = 16$ 

A four by four is a mean machine. I'm going to get one when I'm 16.

 $8 \times 8 = 64$ 

I ate and I ate and I fell on the floor. Couldn't get up till I was 64.

OR 8 x 8 = 64

I ate and I ate till I was sick on the floor. Eight times eight is sixty four.

 $9 \times 9 = 81$ 

Line to line helps Katie plan. Nine times nine is eighty one.  $7 \times 8 = 56$ 

Line them up and that is it! Seven times eight is fifty six. 5 6 7 8


