RETURNING TO SCHOOL:

We are very, very excited to be back for a new school year and are all looking forward to working with you and your children, to ensure they receive the best education possible, not only developing their knowledge but also nurturing their wellbeing.

We will be continuing with the staggered drop off and pick up arrangements as last year, with all children being welcomed by staff at the various gates. This really helped build their independence skills last year, so we aim to develop that further.

We are still not through the pandemic so we ask that you do not gather at the school gates and maintain a 2m distance between you and any other adult. If you can park further away from the gate and walk down this will help with congestion. Please do not park on the yellow No Parking zone at the gate, as children cannot cross the road safely if cars stop here. All children will be regularly handwashing and extra cleaning will remain in place, and well ventilated rooms. Books and school bags can now go back and forth between home and school.

There will be no snack available this week.

COVID GUIDANCE:

PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL IF THEY DISPLAY ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS:

- A HIGH TEMPERATURE
- A CONTINUOUS COUGH
- LOSS OF TASTE OR SMELL

IF A CHILD BEGINS TO DISPLAY THESE SYMPTOMS IN SCHOOL, THEY WILL BE SENT HOME. AT THIS POINT YOU SHOULD BOOK A COVID TEST.

IF YOUR CHILD IS IDENTIIED AS A CLOSE CONTACT THEY SHOULD SELF ISOLATE AND YOU SHOULD BOOK A TEST FOR THEM. IF THE TEST IS NEGATIVE THEY CAN END THEIR SELF-ISOLATION, AND TAKE ANOTHER TEST ON DAY 8.

IF THEY DEVELOP SYMPTOMS AT ANY TIME THEY SHOULD IMMEDIATELY SELF ISOLATE, EVEN IF EARLIER TESTS WERE NEGATIVE.

IF ANY TESTS ARE POSITIVE, THIS MEANS THEY HAVE THE VIRUS AND THEY SHOULD SELF-ISOLATE FOR 10 DAYS IN LINE WITH GOVERNMENT GUIDANCE.
